RESOLUTION OF A SIGNIFICANT SAFETY CONCERN (SSC) — NEPAL

1. The Council, at the twelfth meeting of its 179th Session, approved the mechanism for addressing Significant Safety Concerns (SSCs) identified during the conduct of safety oversight activities under the Universal Safety Oversight Audit Programme (USOAP).
2. In July 2013, ICAO identified an SSC pertaining to the certification process for the issuance of air operator certificates in Nepal. In accordance with the mechanism approved by the Council, the State has implemented corrective actions to resolve the SSC. As a result, the SSC is no longer posted on the ICAO USOAP CMA online framework (<https://www.icao.int/usoap>).
3. Presently, six SSCs identified by ICAO remain unresolved. The ICAO Member States with unresolved SSCs that remain posted on the secure website are the following: Djibouti, Eritrea, Haiti, Kyrgyzstan, Malawi and Thailand.
